The 2024 Early Learning Conference will focus on "School Readiness: The Whole Child." The intent of this topic is to help early educators understand what they can do to help families, schools, communities, and organizations be ready for children rather than just focusing on helping children be ready for school.

Professional learning sessions will be presented in-person at the Conference and are typically 1.25 hours in length. Hands-on learning modalities are highly encouraged. Sessions may be offered in English and/or Spanish.
